History

Hixny

- Hixny is a health information exchange (HIE), which is a secure network used by healthcare organizations, providers and patients to share health information.
- Hixny also is referred for state regulations as a state-qualified entity (QE) and share information through the Statewide Health Information Network for New York (SHIN-NY) that follows guidelines and regulations set by the New York eHealth Collaborative (NYeC) under the direction of the New York State Department of Health (DOH).

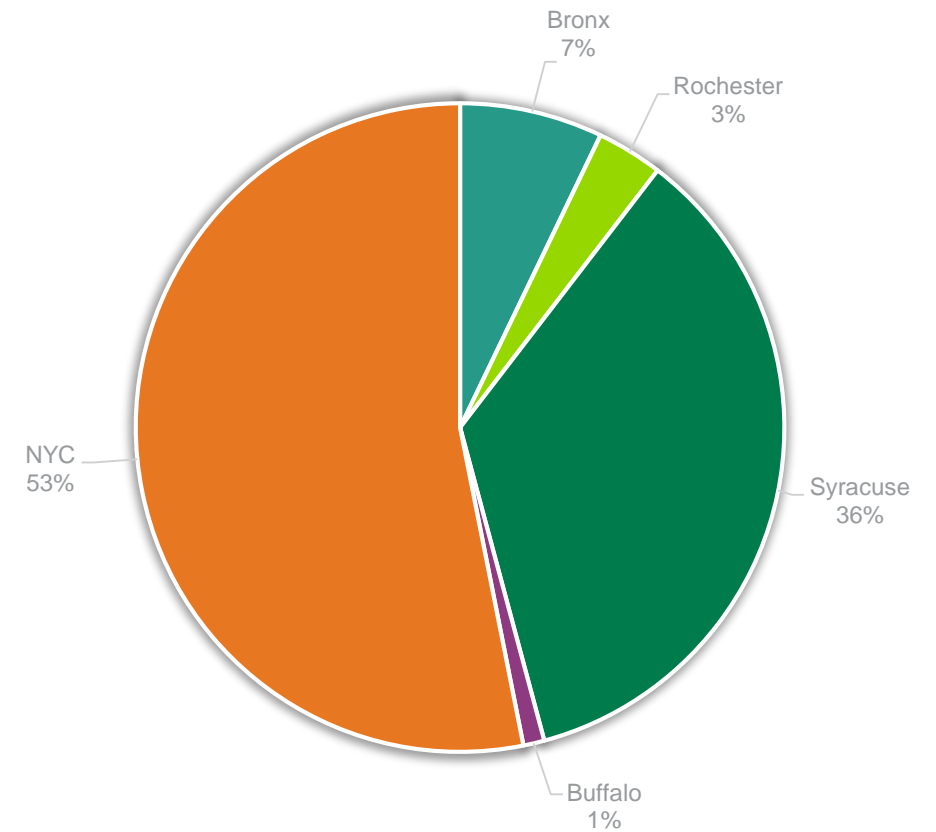
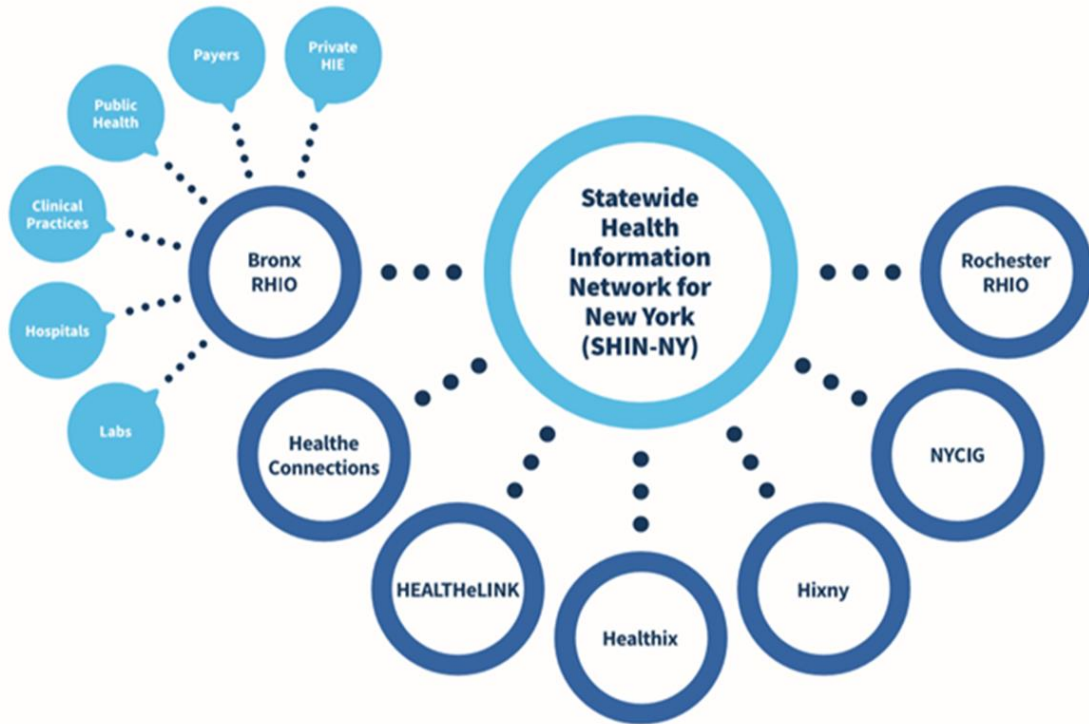
20 Year Anniversary!

Consent

Consent is your key!

- Consent is by Legal Entity
- Consent is “once and done*”
 - Meaning, an office needs to obtain a patient’s consent once in his/hers lifetime; does not need to be obtained every year
 - Unless you treat minors, you will have to recollect consent when they become 18 years old
- Data is always flowing to the HIE (it’s a law)! Where consent comes into play is to view and access patient information.
 - **Participating organizations do not need the patient’s permission to send their data to Hixny!**
 - This includes sensitive information such as HIV results, genetic testing, substance abuse and mental health issues
 - The patient’s control is to either grant access or deny access to the organization in order to view his/hers community health/medical record

Hixny's Core Services

Core Services

- Hixny Provider Portal
 - Reports & Transcribed Documents, etc.
 - Alerts – Delivered in Clinical Message Center (CMC)
 - ED Admit/Discharge, Inpatient Admit/Discharge
- Direct Implementation with Electronic Health Records
 - Examples: Meditech, Epic, Cerner, Medent, Athena, etc.

Accessing Data

- Demographics
- Allergies
- Medications
- Problem lists/diagnoses
- Procedures
- Lab results
- Image reports
- Immunizations
- Progress & consult notes
- Discharge summaries
- ED reports
- Other transcribed reports
- EKG Tracings
- Vital signs

Care Coordination and Hixny

Social Determinants of Health (SDOH)

- Conditions in the places where people live, learn, work, and play affect a wide range of health risks and outcomes.
- Social Determinants of Health (SDOH) impact population health outcomes.
 - Examples: gender, life expectancy, access to healthcare services, transportation, race, socioeconomic status (SES), smoke-free housing, proximity to grocery store, violence in neighborhood

Care Coordinators/Managers & Data

- Information gathering
 - Discharge Planning
 - Care Coordination (Home Care)
- Improve care coordination efforts
 - Prevention
 - Treatment
 - Maintenance
- Population Health Outcomes
 - Better Care (Individual and Population Level)
 - Lower Cost
 - Improved Patient Experience
