Watch Out for Scams!

As you look for your best health coverage options, keep an eye open for fraudsters who:

- Claim they are an "official Medicare agent".
 There are no Medicare representatives.
- Say you <u>must</u> join a Medicare prescription plan (also known as Part D). It is voluntary to join a Medicare prescription drug plan.
- Call to verify your Medicare number or Social Security number. Medicare or Social Security will never call you to verify your number.
- Threaten or pressure you to enroll in their plan. You will not lose your benefits and have the entire Open Enrollment Period to decide.

If you suspect your Medicare number has been compromised or believe you have been enrolled in a plan without your permission, call the NYS Senior Medicare Patrol at 800-333-4374

FREE COVID test kits are now available for order from the US Government. You can order four tests per US household through <u>covidtests.gov</u>

People without internet connection can call 800-232-0233 to request tests.
